PPC Executive Committee Meeting Notes – 12/5/17

The group discussed plans for the December general meeting, scheduled for Dec. 19. It will be a holiday social event, so executive committee members, and others, are asked to bring some holiday snack foods for popular enjoyment. Members are also asked to bring along a display of print photos that fit the acronym CHRISTMAS, as indicated below:

We will also be selecting member photos for the Spring show at the Dunning Gallery.
